#### Introduction

It is with delight to once again announce this year's BKA Spring Jodo and Iaido Seminar and Grading incorporating a Shinpan (refereeing) seminar. It should be noted from the outset that this seminar will be useful for everyone regardless of their grade or experience. The Shinpan Seminar will help to identify important points to observe in one's performance of Jodo and Iaido and so will be useful for student and teacher alike.

#### Venue

For the first time we are trying out Bath University and their Sports Training Village (see <a href="http://www.teambath.com">http://www.teambath.com</a> for more information) as our venue. The venue has excellent sport facilities. We will be using two particular halls and will need to transfer between them occasionally throughout the event. Bath is a very beautiful old city located in Somerset and has within it many interesting historical sites including the remains of a Roman bath located in a popular museum (see link for more information: <a href="http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Bath">http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Bath</a>. Somerset). It is worth spending a few days in this area and visiting the local tourist interests.

## Seminar

The events will take place according to the following schedule:

The timings for each day are as follow:

- 09:30 Seminar morning session
- 12:30 Lunch
- 14:00 Seminar afternoon session
- 17:30 Seminar close

On this occasion we have requested Ishido Sensei to lead a seminar focused on developing observation and judgment skills in the scenario of a taikai. Aside from the procedures for how to behave as a taikai judge there are many areas of technical observance which are important and useful for all levels of Jodo and Iaido which Ishido Sensei will be looking at. Furthermore this will be especially useful for those preparing for a grading or wishing to develop their skills as a grading panelist.

It should be pointed out that in contrast to the usual seminar, there will not be as much time for practice and personal instruction therefore those who are taking a grading should (as is always the case) ensure they are prepared to grade before arrival at the event.

### Grading

Jodo grading will be on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March up to and including 5th Dan.

laido grading will be on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> March up to and including 5th Dan.

BKA members are requested to register online. The grading application process will close by

- Jodo: 1<sup>st</sup> March 2013
- laido: 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2013

Non-BKA members are requested to either a) register online through the seminar booking process and pay beforehand or b) contact the relevant grading officer and pay for registration and menjo on the day of the grading. You will also need to provide a letter of permission from your own federation to take part in the grading.

#### Car parking

#### Public transport

**Train:** Bath Spa station has frequent services to London, Bristol and South Wales, allowing connections to the rest of the UK. Visit <u>www.nationalrail.co.uk</u> for information.

**Bus:** There are regular bus services from the train station to campus (and around town). You can plan your journey using Traveline South West at <u>www.travelinesw.com</u>. As you exit the train station from the main entrance the bus station is located to the left on Dorchester Street.

**Air:** The nearest airport is Bristol International Airport. There are also regular connections by rail or coach from London Heathrow.
